## ADOPTED AS REVISED

### RESOLUTION

1 RESOLVED, That the American Bar Association urges federal, state, local, tribal  
2 and territorial governments to enact laws and regulations and to develop policies  
3 that assure that once an individual has been identified as an adult or minor victim  
4 of human trafficking, that individual should:

6 (a) not be ~~prosecuted~~ subjected to arrest, prosecution or punishment for  
7 crimes related to their prostitution or other non-violent crimes that are a  
8 direct result of their status as an adult or minor victim of human trafficking;

10 (b) be offered ~~housing~~ ~~in circumstances~~ appropriate for a victim;  
11

12 (c) be provided appropriate protection, to include the individual's family, if a  
13 threat to safety exists from the person or persons responsible for the  
14 trafficking or others; and

16 (d) be assured that their names and identifying information will not be  
17 disclosed to the public.
